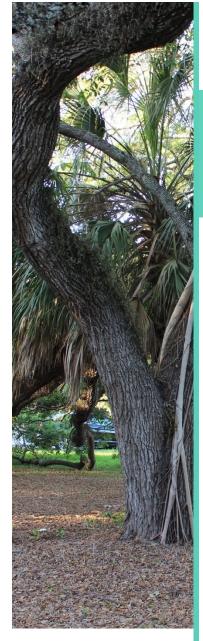

To develop a long-range, communitybased master plan for the War Memorial Youth Center.



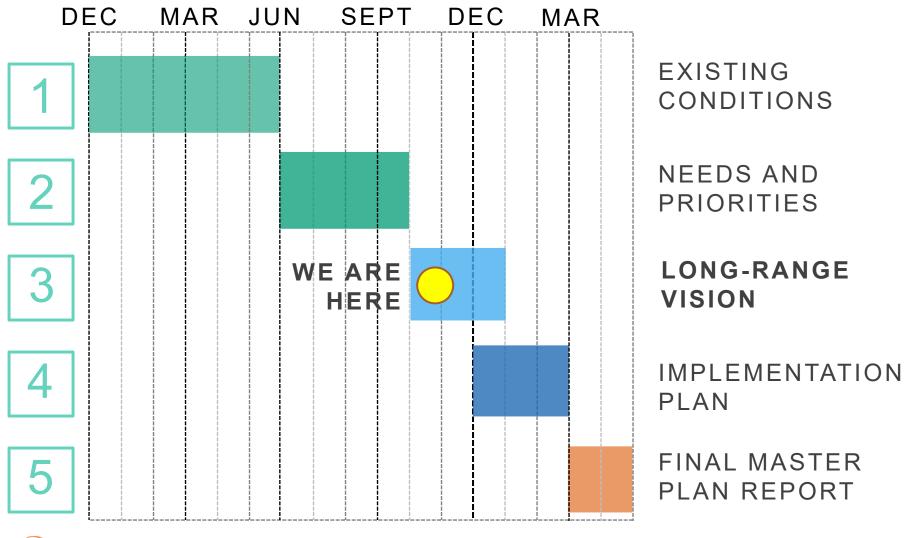

# MASTER PLAN OBJECTIVES

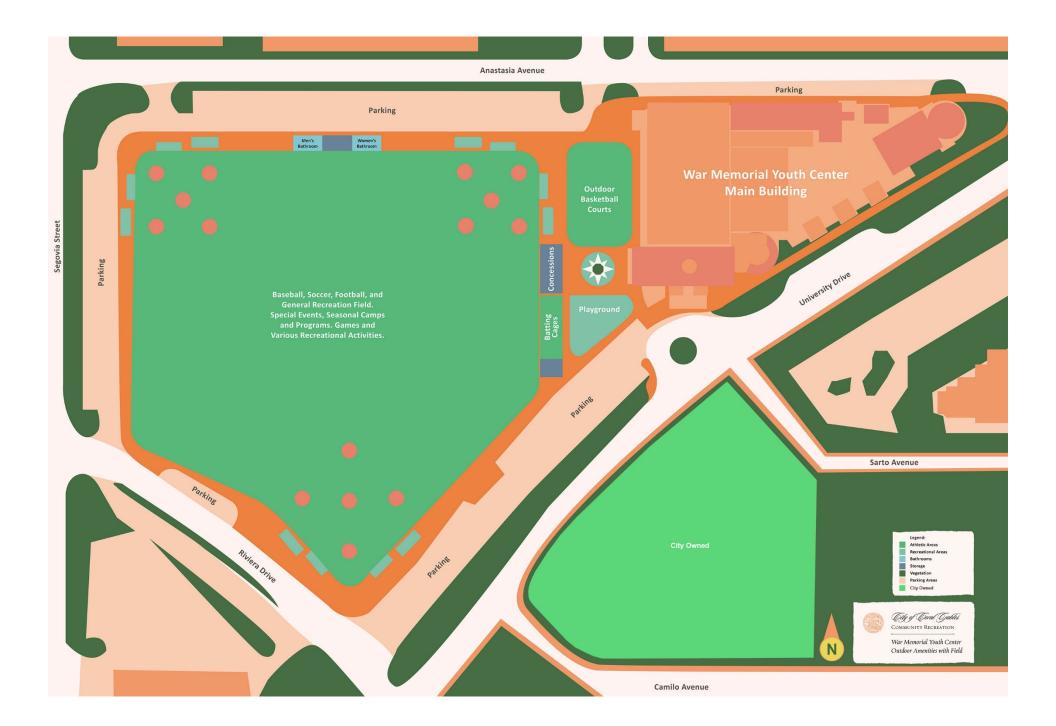
- Complete a comprehensive and transparent needs and priorities assessment;

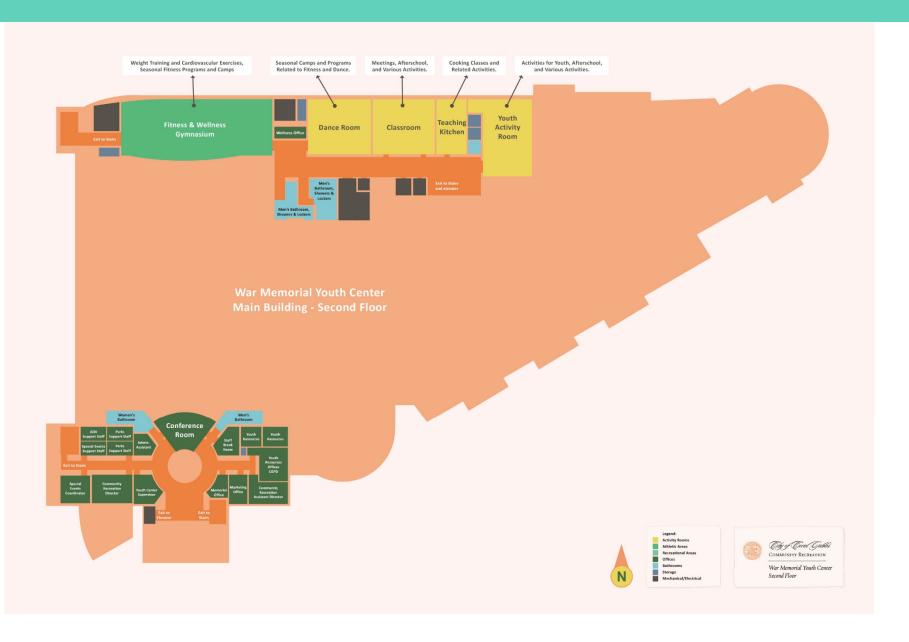

## FACILITY EVALUATION

Organizational elements of the facility have evolved over time according to the express needs and desires of members/residents; the facility has been more or less able to evolve to accommodate these changes.

## FACILITY - RECREATION AMENITIES

- Interior basketball courts are inadequate for current needs presented by basketball leagues.
- Existing gymnastics space is adequate for the program.
- Interstitial space between circulation and gymnastics space is awkward and hard to program.
- Existing fitness facility is inadequate in size and in quality; unable to compete with commercial facilities.
- Lockers/bathrooms for existing fitness facility are inadequate.







# FACILITY - COMMUNITY AMENITIES

- Existing east courtyard is not effective in its current design not enough shade; unusable in many months of the year.
- Theater/performance space could benefit by an expansion.
- Existing second level recreation/activity rooms vary in quality and effectiveness for their programs; several rooms, including ceramics and cooking, are designed for programs that no longer exist.
- Spaces may benefit by being designed in a more flexible way, where each space might be usable by different programs.







## SITE AMENITIES

- Baseball / soccer fields work well for the heavy use by soccer and softball leagues.
- Turf on existing fields has been recently refurbished.
- Existing concessions building could use a larger food prep spaces as well as a rooftop viewing level that could be used to view the entire field area.
- Exterior basketball courts are heavily used.
- Existing monument is hard to clean and maintain.







# **ADMINISTRATIVE**

- Several spaces on the second level administrative area are leased to outside entities.
- The large conference room on the second floor suffers from acoustical problems.
- Enclosing area above entry could be additional administrative space on the second level.







## **FACILITY FUNCTIONALITY**

- Lobby bathrooms need to be re-configured for security.
- Storage rooms and support spaces on the ground level are currently ineffective with a lack of adequate shelving and overall organization.
- Delivery area on the north side of the building is adequate and operates effectively.
- Existing building is hardened for hurricanes with the use of metal hurricane panels. Panels are difficult and time consuming to install and take down.

## FOCUS GROUP THEMES

- 1. Expand athletics and offerings and improve quality programing at the Youth Center by better utilizing the existing property, rooms, and facilities.
- 2. Enhance pedestrian and biking access to Youth Center by incorporating bike facilities 7. Improve communication to users and such as covered and lighted bike parking at the Youth Center to encourage non-vehicular transit.
- 3. Evaluate addition of a protected walking path/running track around the Youth Center 8. Redesign the hurricane preparedness that could be used by residents with special needs and children.
- 4. Evaluate redesign of the Youth Center that could be implemented in phases by building on the fields and redeveloping outdoor facilities where the buildings are currently.
- 5. Consider converting existing fields at the Youth Center to synthetic turf to extend playable time.

- 6. Explore enhancements at the Youth Center for youth-oriented service such as afterschool transportation, academic support and tutoring, and access to fitness area (with supervision).
- residents that the War Memorial Youth Center programs and facilities are inclusive to people of all ages with diverse types of special needs.
- system for the War Memorial Youth Center in order to increase efficiency of preparing and reopening the facility.
- 9. Consider rebuilding the outdoor bathrooms and concessions in a new, combined facility near the fields.
- 10. Create development of a second floor over the courtyard to add additional facilities.

- 3. Expand facilities and programming capacity for Coral Gables residents.
- 4. Increase child/youth-focused play areas, education, and athletics.
- 5. Create **meditative/exercise spaces** at the Youth Center.

- 6. Incorporate accessibility into Youth Center and programming for special populations.
- 7. Expand diversity of athletics programming at the Youth Center.
- 8. Promote a holistic, multi-generational, family-centered community.

- Random/ stratified to match each sample zone's demographics

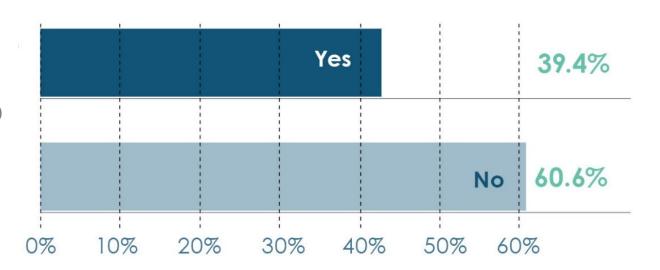

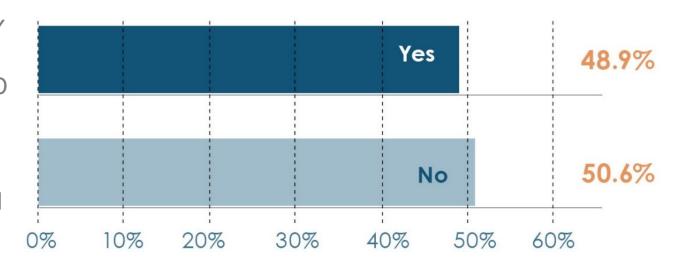

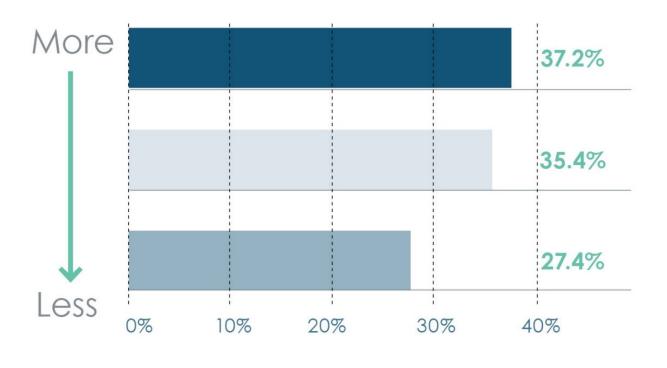

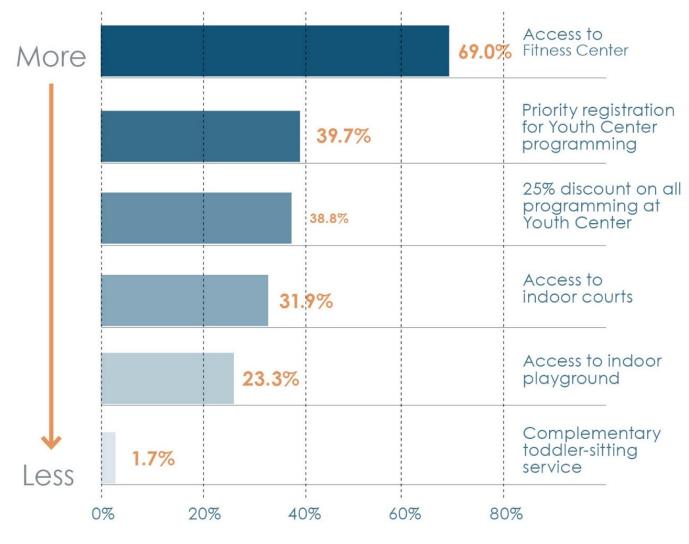

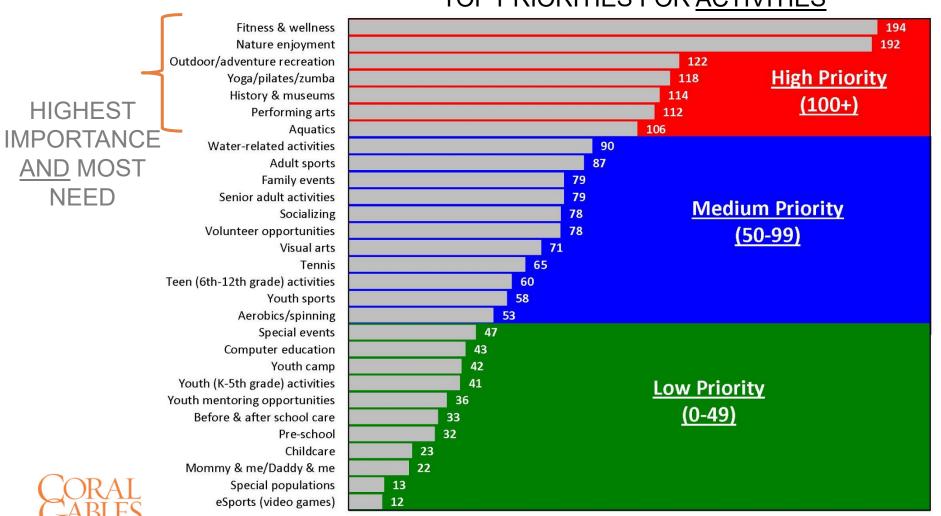
