

How does the CashKey work?

CashKeys are pre-programmed for \$25, \$50, \$75 or \$100 in value. When you fully insert the CashKey, it displays the value remaining on the key. Since the meter cannot display decimal points, it rounds down to the nearest whole dollar. The meter then deducts \$.25 from the programmed amount and registers the time on the meter. To register additional time on the meter, re-insert the CashKey.

The CashKey does not need to be completely removed before reinsertion, so be careful to avoid unintentional reinsertions.

When the amount of time desired has been registered, remove the CashKey and take it with you. Again, please be careful since the meter will not register more than the maximum time, but will continue to deduct \$.25 from your CashKey each time it is inserted.

If the key is left inserted for more than five seconds, the meter will go into an out-of-order mode until the CashKey is removed. This is to alert you if you have inadvertently left the CashKey in the meter.

to the City...

Coral Gables Cash Key



You don't have to be royalty or a celebrity

to get a key to the City of Coral Gables. You can have a key, a CashKey, that will save you from filling your pockets with needless coins if you want to use the electronic parking meters at The City Beautiful.

What do the meters cost?

The meters will accept nickels, dimes, and quarters and will display the desired time at the rate indicated on the meter. Please remember that these meters will only register coins up to the maximum time allowed for. Besides accepting coins, the meters also accept the CashKey which can be purchased at the Parking Department and other participating locations.

What happens when the money runs out in the CashKey?

When you purchase a CashKey, a non-resident is charged a deposit of \$15 for the key in addition to the requested credit amount of \$25, \$50, \$75 or \$100. The deposit fee on up to two keys is waived for residents. When the amount programmed on the CashKey is finally exhausted, you may return it to the Parking Department or any of the

other locations listed below and purchase more time.

Please check with the Parking Department to be sure that our other CashKey service locations have not changed.

What if I move and need a refund?

You may return an undamaged CashKey to the Parking Department. A check for the value remaining on the CashKey and your deposit, minus a \$5 administrative fee, will be mailed to you.

What if I lose the CashKey?

Without the CashKey, the City has no basis for knowing how much money is left programmed on the key, or whether it is found and used by another party. Therefore, no refunds or deposits can be issued for lost keys.

What if my CashKey is damaged?

CashKeys are extremely durable and are not affected by exposure to rain, heat or other conditions. They are also not affected

by magnetic or X-ray exposures such as in airport terminals. As is the case with a lost key, unless the City can determine the amount of funds still left on the damaged key, no refunds will be issued for damaged CashKeys.

Can I purchase more than one CashKey?

Yes, however, a non-resident is charged a \$15 deposit for each CashKey, while a resident will be charged the deposit when purchasing more than two CashKeys. It is more cost effective to purchase one CashKey and bring it back to the City to be reprogrammed.

Can I use coins and the CashKey together?

Yes. The electronic meters will accept either one. It will also distinguish between foreign coins and slugs. In fact, since the electronic meters will only show the whole dollar amount left on your key, you may wish to have a few coins for those times when your key runs out before you reach the needed time on your meter.

How do I get a CashKey?

You can purchase a CashKey at the Coral Gables Parking Department located at 2801 Salzedo St., Second Floor. The office is open to the public Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. You can pay the \$15 deposit and purchase a \$25, \$50, \$75 or \$100 CashKey by cash, check, or credit card.
